Keep your cool on third floor with a refreshing stop for an ice-cold root beer float in the 1940s Miller's Lunch diner, once a culinary landmark in Le Mars. Climb all the way to the fourth floor - or take the elevator - to the newest exhibit in the Study Hall: "Through the Years of Black and White." See Dick and Glada Koerselman photography from decades of community journalism. Out on the Museum grounds, tour the Weber Log Cabin, a Civil War era cabin from western Plymouth County; and Joy Hollow Log Cabin, built in the 1890s in Sioux City.

**Saturday 12:00 - 5:00 p.m. - It's Log Cabin Day at the Museum!** Check out the sounds of cowboys and Indians on the lawn, weather permitting.
